Attractively scented, the 2022 vintage (4.5*) was grown at sites in the Wairau Valley, Waihopai Valley and Southern Valleys, and tank-fermented, with 'a touch of neutral oak'. Pale lemon/green, it is a distinctive, lively wine, with strong, fresh, passionfruit-like flavours, citrusy notes, vibrant acidity, excellent delicacy and a dry (2.8 grams/litre of residual sugar), lengthy finish.
